■ **EXERCISES**

1. Presentation of the project 3MFG. Presentation of the results of the questionnaires.
2. Connection between the Theme and the Jubilee of the Kindergarten (KITA).

3. A game- how am I feeling as a dish (warming game)
4. A game- Once upon a time...was a kindergarten, where....(the teacher had to write sentences and to finish the fairytale)
5. The tree of the small gumibärchen small people- each participant muss paint one of these gumibärchen and to explain (work in pairs) why chooses this small ...and how describe your place in the tree of life now.
6. Working in two groups- Generation communication- personal and principle questions
7. Discussion in the small groups
8. Discussion in the big group
9. Final conclusions
10. A game for closing the workshop- Applauses
